Therefore, he needs to commute between his home in London and his university in Essex on a daily basis, both to enable him to continue studying and also to be close to his mother. He is currently getting a rain every day at a cost of £70 a week. Driving will not only be more cost and time effective, it will also allow him much easier access between the two locations.
